Thank you for registering to the upcoming webinar from the EMES International Research Network #mapandcompass series - here comes #Zaragoza!

Sessions

On the 27th of May (2021), your PhD Reps and [Rocío Nogales](#), Executive Director of EMES, will be delivering the following three sessions.

- Session 1. Participants will meet in a one-to-one short informal session where using a zoo animal analogy they will be asked to introduce themselves and their PhD stage to another participant. Participants will be randomly assorted into couples every four minutes. Each couple will have 4 minutes to talk, ideally 2 min per person. This process will occur 5 times, so every participant will meet 5 other participants.
- Session 2. Participants will be grouped according to their thematic lines. Each group will be moderated by one PhD Rep. Questions, topics for discussion and a short task will be provided by the moderator to encourage participation. They will be asked to prepare a question/doubt regarding the conference to be addressed by Rocío in the next and last section.
- In the third and last session, [Rocío Nogales](#) will explain briefly the blended format of the 8th EMES conference, and will address the questions that the participants formulated in the previous session.
